

LEARNING SERVICES TYPES OF SUPPORT:

The following types of support are available through student services here at Chief Dan George Middle School:

- Academic (learning assistance in both French and English)
- Behavioral
- English as a Second Language
- Individual programming
- Liaison with community groups (Impact, Mental Health, etc.)
- Indigenous

FORMS OF SUPPORT:

Support may be provided in a wide variety of ways as listed below:

- In class help - Individual pull-out
- Group pull-out

ACCESS TO SUPPORT:

If you believe your child is having academic/learning difficulties, the first step is to talk with the child's homeroom teacher. If the problem cannot be solved and more help is indicated, the teacher will refer your child to the school based team who will try to find the best way to provide support. If the teacher felt that your child was having academic difficulties, they would of course, contact you first outlining concerns and together you would decide if more services should be considered. If your child is having emotional difficulties, or you feel that your child would benefit from school counseling you may call the school directly. Darlene Cotten would be the contact.
